# Lake Claire Pool | Party Policy

## What constitutes a party and why?

If you are bringing more than five (5) guests you are required to book and pay as a party.

## Who counts as a guest?

Members are considered party guests if they are invited to your party and must be included on the sign up sheet. Adult supervisors count as party guests (1 adult per 5 children).

## Party Fees & Number of guests permitted:

Parties are limited to 20 people. This total includes adult supervisors for a child's party.

## Party Fee: Rates through Sweetwater\*

\*Members will be charged a \$100 clean up fee if the party area is not cleaned up after the party ends.

## Pool Availability for parties:

Parties are only allowed during open pool hours. Parties are booked on a first come, first serve basis. Check pool calendar on website for availability.

## The pool is not available for parties during high volume times:

- Opening Weekend (Typically mid-May)
- Memorial Day Weekend- Sat, Sun, Mon
- July 4th Weekend – Fri, Sat, Sun
- Labor Day Weekend- Sat, Sun, Mon
- Any evenings Lake Claire Pool has a home swim meet
- Any Fridays after 3:00 PM ALL summer

## Member Responsibilities

1. Submit a party request, confirm, and pay the party fee in advance.
2. Be on site at the party from start to finish.
3. Set up a party (feel free to arrive 30 min before)--lifeguards can assist as needed. You can set up in the snack room or on the pool deck--check with lifeguards.
4. Bring a guest roster to lifeguard on duty for easy check-in of your guests.
5. Accept full responsibility for the conduct of all party guests.
6. Cleaning party area (\$100 fine if not cleaned). Ask the lifeguard for a broom/dust pan.
7. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in cancellation of party booking.

## Member Supervision Requirement

For every 5 guests under the age of 18, you must have one adult to supervise; this adult must be included in your total group number. The adults are to be in close proximity to the under-18 year old guests. These adults should assist with behavior and be aware of all pool rules (found on our website)
